The DJ will play softer music during your cocktail hour and dinner at a lower volume level. If you're having toasts, we'll do them towards the end of dinner. After that, the DJ will start the dancing off. A wide variety of music for all ages will be played for approximately 30 to 45 minutes, followed by the Cake Cutting.

For the **Cake Cutting**, we generally do, "Sugar, Sugar" by the Archies and "Pour Some Sugar on Me" by Def Leppard. Are these songs ok?

After the Cake Cutting will be more dancing time. Depending on the length of your reception and punctuality of the overall schedule so far, this may be 30-45 minutes, or it may be much less. This is where the DJ will need to shave time off the schedule if things are running behind.

Next the Bouquet Toss and Garter Ceremony will take place. The DJ will announce that we are about to toss the bouquet, and that all the single ladies need to converge in one confined area, this may take several announcements from the DJ. When you hear the DJ announce this, please help to gather all the single ladies and inform them of what is about to happen.

For the Bouquet Toss, we generally do "Single Ladies" by Beyonce, or "Ladies Night" by Kool & The Gang. Which of these songs would you prefer, or do you have another choice? Please indicate song of your choice here:

## The Garter Ceremony consists of 2 parts:

**Part 1** - the Groom removes the garter from Bride's leg, and then tosses it over his shoulder. After removal of the Garter, as the song is still playing, the DJ then announces that all the single guys must converge in one area. Then just as the Bride tossed the bouquet, the Groom will toss the Garter. During Part 1 of the Garter Ceremony, we generally play "Let's Get it On" or "Sexual Healing" by Marvin Gaye.

**Part 2** - The DJ announces that we need the girl who caught the bouquet and the guy who caught the garter back to the dance floor area. Some nice gentleman will bring her a chair to sit in. The guy who caught the bouquet will then place the garter onto one leg of the girl who caught the bouquet. During Part 2 of the Garter Ceremony, we generally play "Legs" by ZZ Top. Is this song ok? Depending on how much time is left, we can either immediately follow with the Shoe Game or Dollar Dance (if applicable), or we can open the dance floor back up.

After the optional activities, the dance floor will be open until the end of the reception, and the Bride & Groom's Last Dance, if there is one.

To fill the dance floor when necessary, the DJ will generally play the songs that have their own dance all in sequence. If you would prefer these songs be played or not played, please indicate YES or NO. If you leave it up to the DJ, he will "feel the crowd out" and will either play some of them, none of them, or all of them based on the crowd's reaction.
